Since its inception in 1994, the Asia-Pacific Space Geodynamics (APSG) Program has been actively involving scientists from nearly twenty countries to conduct cooperative research to study geodynamics problems in the Asian-Pacific region.

This symposium is the 5th in its series. The recent devastating tragedy resulted from the strong earthquake in the Indian Ocean and the subsequent tsunami indicate the strong needs to step up our research in understanding and preventing natural hazards in this region. This symposium provides a good opportunity for geoscientists to discuss such issues among others.

The symposium will be held right before the AOGS annual meeting in Singapore to make it easier for participants to attend the two events consecutively.

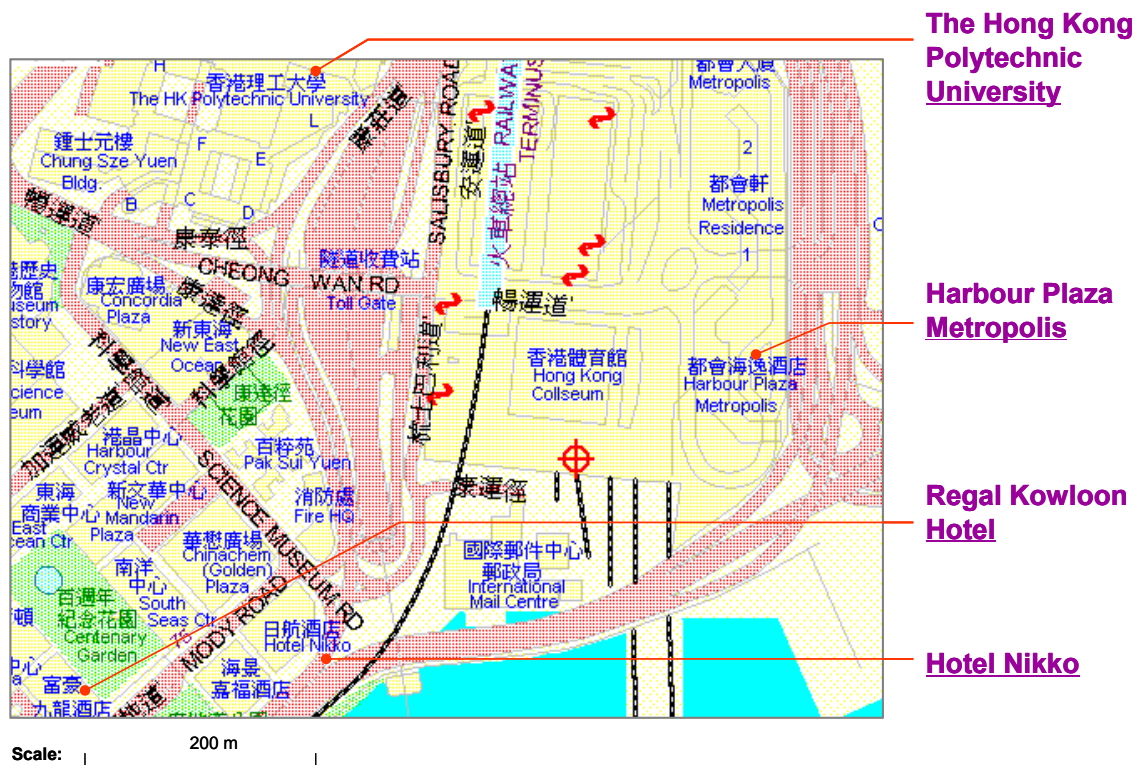
